

NVIDIA DISPLAY MODE SELECTOR TOOL LICENSE

IMPORTANT NOTICE - READ CAREFULLY: This license is the agreement which governs use of the NVIDIA Display Mode Selector tool, including computer software and associated materials (collectively, "SOFTWARE") provided by NVIDIA Corporation ("NVIDIA").
